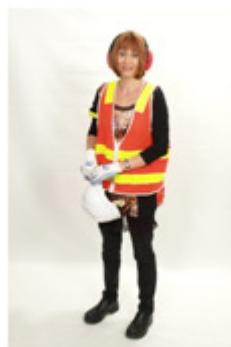


Benefits to You
